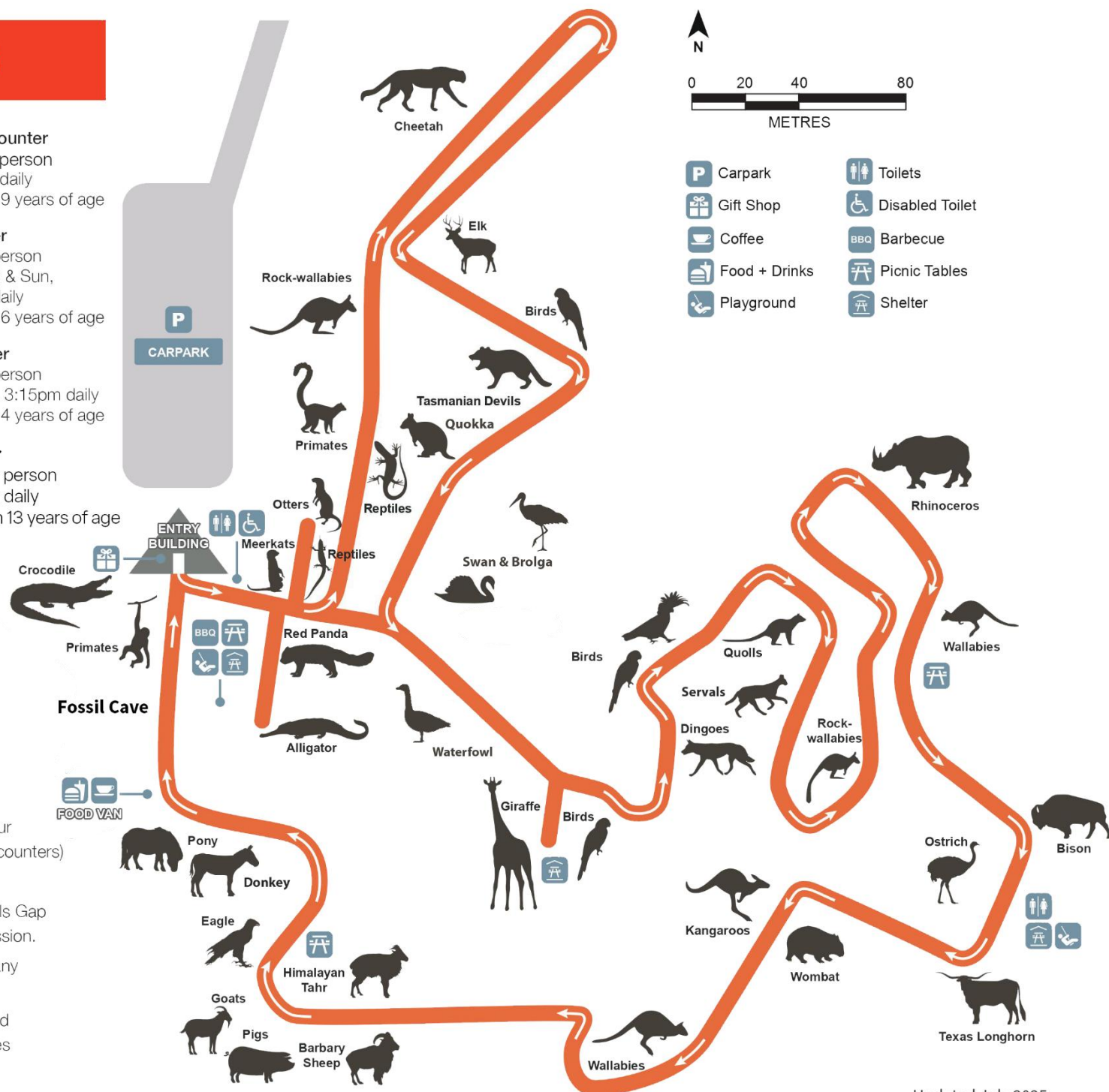

Hand Washing Protocol

In the interest of public safety, visitors are reminded that wildlife can potentially carry zoonotic diseases. Follow these hand washing directions after contact with animals and before eating, drinking or smoking.

- Wet hands thoroughly and lather with soap.
- Rub hands vigorously for at least 10-15 seconds.
- Rinse hands well under running water.
- Dry hands with paper towel.

Welcome to Halls Gap Zoo, please enjoy your day exploring our zoo. There are over 120 species on display.

For your enjoyment and the safety of our animals, please follow these guidelines

- **Special animal food may be purchased at the entry.**

It can be fed to the Deer, Kangaroos, Wallabies, Himalayan Tahr, Peacocks, Guinea Fowl, Emu, Goats and Ostrich ONLY

- When feeding, hold food with a flat hand below animal's eye level. Alternatively, place a small amount of feed on the ground
- To avoid the worst of the day's heat animals will find the coolest, shadiest position within their enclosure where they will lie quietly and breathe slowly. Please be aware of the animal's needs when approaching them on a hot day.
- Children must be supervised at all time.
- Do not cross any barriers, low fences or chains
- Inside the zoo is a smoke-free zone
- Untreated dam water is used throughout the zoo and is not suitable for human consumption
